<u>THE TIDY TOWNS</u> Committee who look after the general upkeep of the Graveyard has observed that despite the excellent work being done by the Rural Social Scheme environmental workers, a considerable amount of dumping is going on within the Graveyard.

The waste segregation silo, at the rear of the new section of the graveyard is being totally abused. Consignments of rubbish from outside sources are being dumped at the silos.

Each year this excess rubbish builds up, and has to be removed at considerable expense.

As a result, we intend to close the silos, we therefore ask all relatives of the deceased buried in the Graveyard to bring all plastic, weeds and soil away with them after cleaning the Graves.

We are hoping to start the path in the new section of the graveyard in the autumn.

HERITAGE sub-committee of Dunmore Tidy Towns have commenced a large project in recent months. The aim is to carry out a full heritage audit of Dunmore Parish. This extensive project will cover archaeology, geology, and natural history, built heritage, traditions/place names and folklore. Partial funding has been granted from Galway Rural Development and contractor Zena Hoctor has been appointed to carry out the work. It is envisaged that the final audit document will form the basis for future heritage projects in the area. Zena will be carrying out her fieldwork over the next few months. We hope to organise two public events in the future to show the progress of the project to the public and get feedback and comment to ensure that the research is comprehensive.
