WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES 27th September 2020 The 106th World Day of Migrants and Refugees will be celebrated on sept.27th. According to the Global Report there are estimated to be 50.8 million displaced persons worldwide. 45.7 million displaced due to conflict and violence and 5.1 million were forced to move because of disasters. Pope Francis' message focuses on the pastoral care for these people and he invites us to reflect on how we welcome the stranger. 'Like Jesus Christ, forced to flee, we should be ready to welcome, protect and integrate displaced persons into our communities. Pope Francis reminds us that the precariousness experienced by many today due to the pandemic is a constant in the lives of displaced people and all too often we stop at statistics and fail to understand the suffering of those on the margins'.
