<u>DUNMORE CHURCH BUILDING UPDATE</u>- The tendering process has now concluded and we are happy to inform you that our local building firm McGough and Walsh, Dunmore/Lavally have been awarded the contract. The work will begin shortly after current restrictions are lifted and will be completed before Christmas.

When our renovations are completed we will have a Church that will serve our community far into the future. This major phase of the renovations will include: full wheelchair access, disability toilets, safe and energy efficient lighting, updated heating system, a day chapel that can also be used for youth and community gatherings, upgrading our sanctuary. Subject to further fundraising we hope also to upgrade our sacristy, sound system and improve our seating. Despite the challenges of Covid-19, people have continued to honour their monthly and yearly pledges. Others have contributed to the project through the Gift A Light fundraiser and we are grateful to all who helped in this regard. Our recent Grant from the All Churches Trust towards the cost of the Day Chapel was another affirmation of our project. In the coming weeks we will be planning with various parish groups how we can continue to provide for the needs of parishioners during the building phase. We intend to publish a bimonthly or quarterly up date.
