As we are restricted to 50 people at each Mass, we ask those who can to come to a weekday Mass and to leave the weekend Masses free for those who are working during the week. We hope to provide a radio service from Garrafrauns and a radio/webcam service from Dunmore Community School. On days where we reach full capacity, we invite people to listen in the car park on parish radio and to receive Communion at the end of Mass.

<u>BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL</u> – The Blessed Sacrament Chapel located at the side entrance of Dunmore Church is open each day at 9 am at Dunmore Church. It gives a place to come and pray or light a candle in a prayerful setting for the duration of our renovations. Adoration takes place on Mondays and Fridays.

<u>ACCESS TO DUNMORE CHURCH</u> – The renovation work at Dunmore Church are now beginning. In the interests of health and safety, it will not be possible to use the main body of the Church during that time. Please note that Dunmore funerals, baptisms and weddings will be moved to Garrafrauns and Kiltevna Churches. Public Masses will be held in Dunmore Community School as well as Garrafrauns and Kiltevna Churches.

THOMAS McKEEVER CENTENARY 20th MAY 1921-20th May 2021 -For health & Safety reasons we are changing the memorial wreath laying ceremony to Thomas McKeever to his grave in Dunmore cemetery on 20th May 2021 at 7pm and not at Clooneen Bridge as previously stated. The occasion is open to all who wish to attend. We are honoring Thomas McKeever who was brutally assassinated by the crown forces on the night of 20th May 1921. We would ask that all who attend to abide by the Covid 19 restrictions in the graveyard.

<u>DUNMORE TIDY TOWNS</u> –Wild Flowers Meadows and Gardens – now is the time to create a wild flower garden or meadow on your property, in this way you will participate in the All Ireland pollinator plan which aims to address the rapid decline in our Bee population, one third of our ninety nine bee species are threatened with extinction with serious consequences for farming and gardening. To establish, cut the grass and allow the wild flowers such as dandelions, clover, knapweed to bloom or alternatively sow wild flowers as if seeding a lawn. Full information can be obtained via the internet <u>www.polinator.ie</u> or google All Ireland pollinator plan. Tidy Towns prepare an area for wildflower planting on the Tuam Road. It is important that only native Irish wild flower varieties are sown in your garden or meadow. Seeds can be purchased in most garden centres. Some information on wild flower planting is available in Eurospar, Dunmore.
