<u>RETURN TO PUBLIC WORSHIP</u> – Thank God we will soon be in a position to return to public worship from May 10th. The schedule of Masses from the 11th of May (Tuesday week) will be as follows:

As we are restricted to 50 people at each Mass, we ask those who can to come to a weekday Mass and to leave the weekend Masses free for those who are working during the week. We hope to provide a radio service from Garrafrauns and a radio/ webcam service from Dunmore Community School. On days where we reach full capacity, we invite people to listen in the car park on parish radio and to receive Communion at the end of Mass.
