As we are restricted to 50 people at each Mass, we ask those who can to come to a weekday Mass and to leave the weekend Masses free for those who are working during the week. We hope to provide a radio service from Garrafrauns and a radio/webcam service from Dunmore Community School. On days where we reach full capacity, we invite people to listen in the car park on parish radio and to receive Communion at the end of Mass.

<u>BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL</u> – The Blessed Sacrament Chapel located at the side entrance of Dunmore Church is open each day at 9 am at Dunmore Church. It gives a place to come and pray or light a candle in a prayerful setting for the duration of our renovations. Adoration takes place on Mondays and Fridays.

ACCESS TO DUNMORE CHURCH – The renovation work at Dunmore Church are now beginning. In the interests of health and safety, it will not be possible to use the main body of the Church during that time. Please note that Dunmore funerals, baptisms and weddings will be moved to Garrafrauns and Kiltevna Churches. Public Masses will be held in Dunmore Community School as well as Garrafrauns and Kiltevna Churches.
