<u>DUNMORE TIDY TOWNS</u> - Competition Result, The Dunmore community were awarded 319 points in this year's competition. This is an increase of eight marks which represents our second best performance in the competition. We are placed 6th in our category and fourteen out of forty five in county Galway. Heritage, Biodiversity, and Wild Flowers and perennial planting, the new Fairgreen walk, School involvement, and the planting of approx 700 native trees received very favourable comments from the Judges. However derelict buildings and the dumping of household waste are preventing us from gaining additional marks. We intend to work closely with the community warden and the department of the environment to combat this problem. If we are to continue to make progress in this competition we need your ideas and suggestions and commitment. We are now working on our campaign for 2023 which will be published in January 2023, your input will be very welcome, so why not come and join us.
