**CHURCH SYNOD – GOD’S PEOPLE LISTENING TOGETHER** - Pope Francis has asked us to pray for the upcoming Church Synod in Rome. The word Synod means “WALKING TOGETHER” and the upcoming Synod will reflect on how the Church - as part of its inner structure - listens to each other, listens together to the Holy Spirit and then discerns together how we move forward as a Christian family responding to the needs of our time. To walk together involves listening and dialoguing. Pope Francis has written to us telling us that “Without Prayer there will be no Synod” and has encouraged us to listen in prayer to God’s word speaking to us at this time, Let us keep this first stage of the Synod in our prayers. The Synod will continue for the next 15 months.
